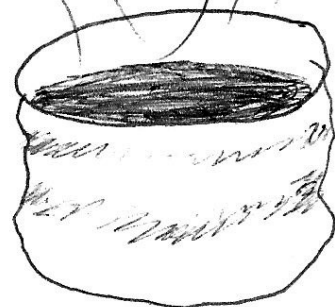

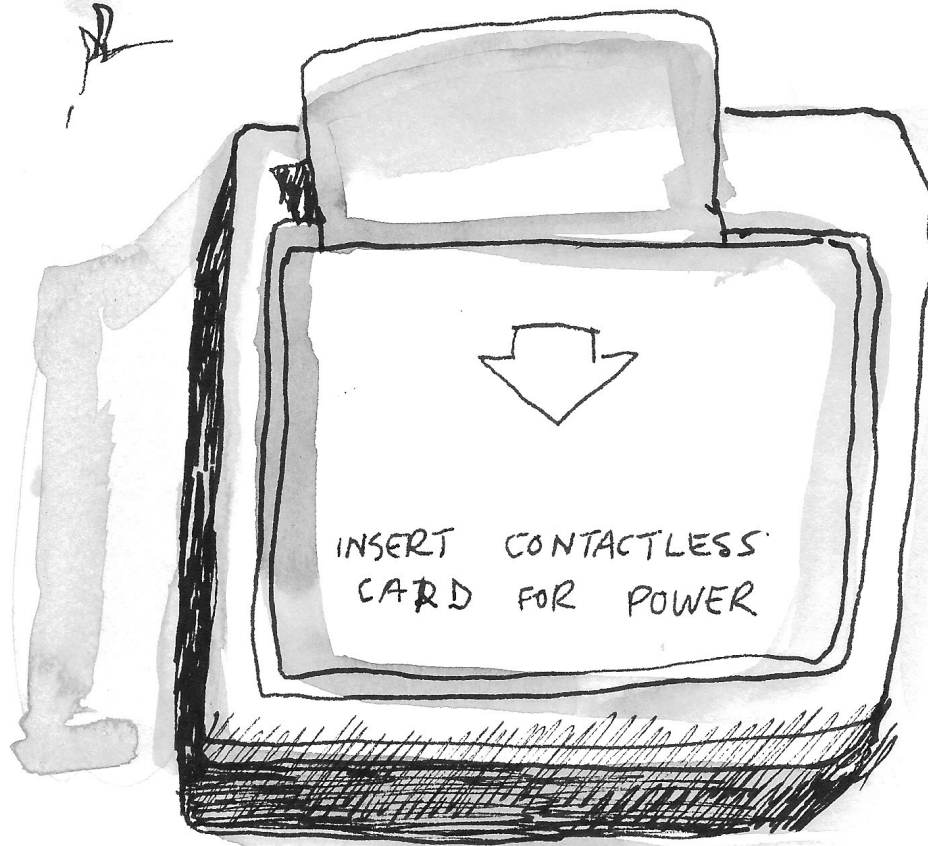

MY DAD WOULD SAY

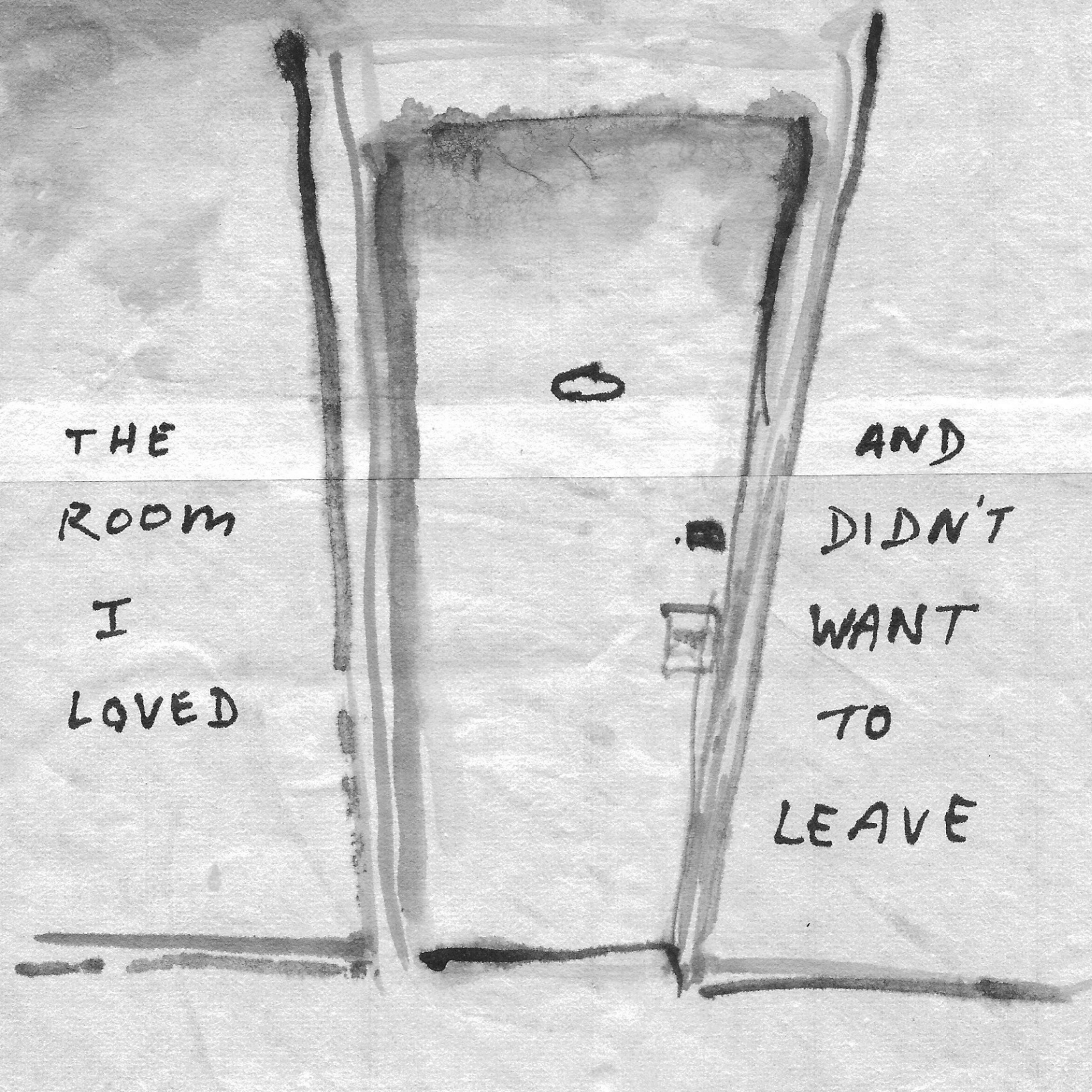

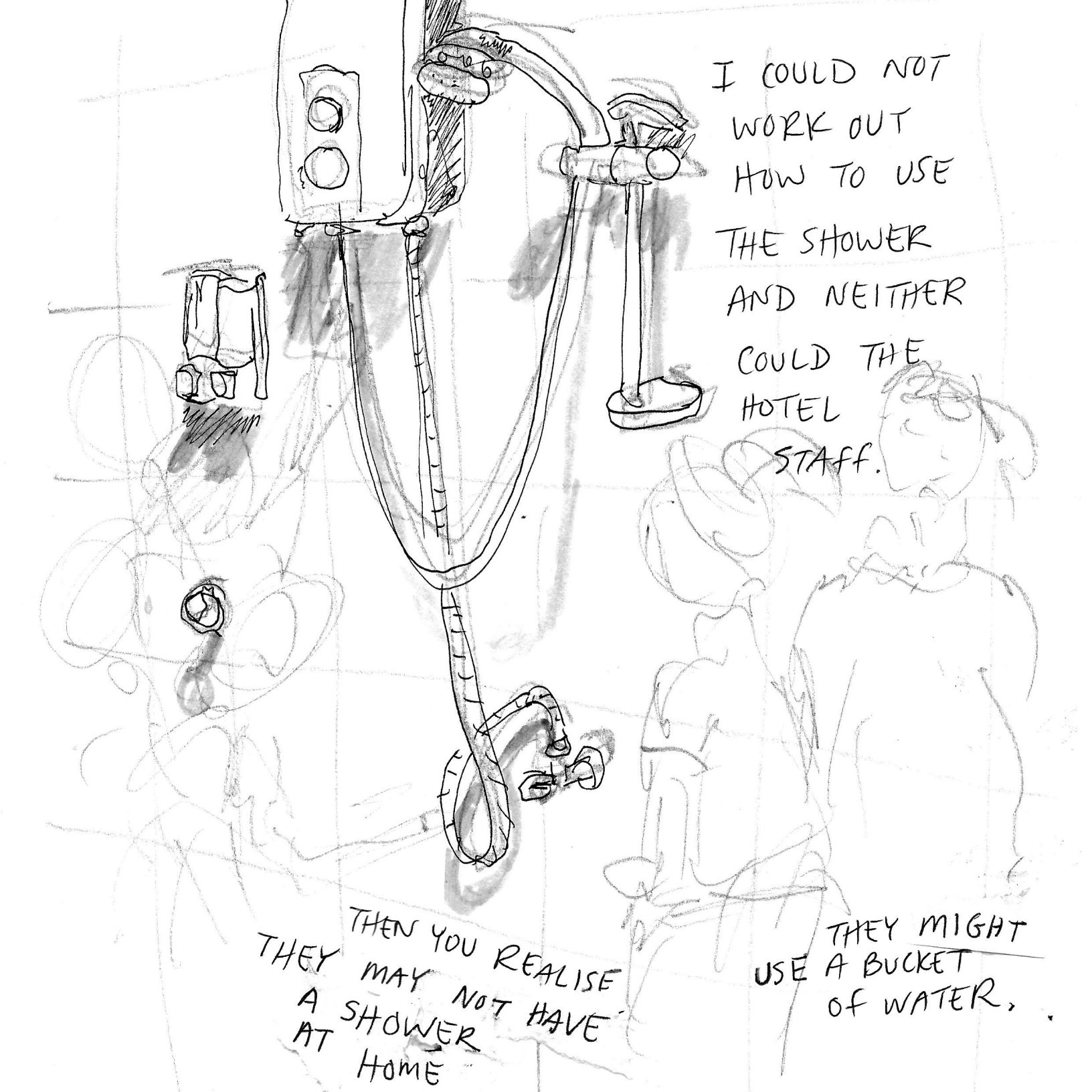
